

## KHS/Polk State College Dual Enrollment Spring 2016

### What are the Benefits of Dual Enrollment?

- ✓ Earn high school and college credit simultaneously for FREE
- ✓ Challenge yourself and prepare for college
- ✓ Set yourself apart in the college admissions process
- ✓ Earn a 1.0 weighting toward your high school GPA

### Who's eligible?

- ✓ Students with a **GPA of 3.0** are eligible. Students with 2.5 Unweighted GPA can take College Success.
  - Students who have earned 6 core HS credits may take up to 1 class per semester (4 credits max)
  - Students who have earned 8 core HS credits may take up to 2 classes per semester (7 credits max)
  - Students who have earned 10 core HS credits may take up to 11 credits per semester IF you have a 3.0 unweighted GPA and have passed all parts to the placement test
- ✓ All dual enrollment classes at KHS, except College Success, require minimum test scores (see tables below):

### How do I Register?

1. Meet with your counselor to determine if dual enrollment is right for you and to see if you are eligible.
2. Apply for admissions to Polk State as a dual enrollment student. Website: <https://passport.polk.edu/Genesis/student/applogon.jsp>.
3. Take the PERT. If you have not done so already, you will need to go to PSC and take all sections of the test. Be sure to take the printout from your application approval with you.
4. Complete the Dual Enrollment Approval Form or DELTA online at <https://delta.polk-fl.net>.
5. Do not forget to have it approved by a parent, a counselor, YOU, and an Administrator.
6. Complete Polk State College's online orientation
7. Take the Dual Enrollment Approval Form and a copy of your test scores (FCAT, ACT, SAT, or PERT) to PSC to register
