Philip Herrington

Philip Herrington, a 2013 KHS/CFAA graduate returns to encourage our students. Philip survived a plane crash and went on to pursue his dreams of becoming a commercial airline pilot. Philip is a first officer with Endeavor Air, an American regional airline that operates as Delta Connection for Delta Air Lines. Thank you Philip for your inspiration for our students!

Engineering students from CFAA, in conjunction with the Aerospace Center for Excellence, have formed a new Unmanned Aircraft Systems Club. The first flights of the Unmanned Squadron took place on Wednesday, September 21, 2016, with 14 club members participating in the after school activities. The club hopes to fly once a week and develop several drones for different purposes. Members of the club



are forming a team for drone competition next April. The club is fully sanctioned through the Academy of Model Aeronautics and is the first UAV Club on an airport property.



The **Academy of Automotive Technology** is tasked with the federal Maintenance and Light Repair program at KHS. The instructor, Mr. Darr invites guest speakers from schools that might help enhance the skills and abilities for his students in a post-secondary environment. Two recent speakers include UNOH and UTI. Phil Carpenter from the **University of Northwestern Ohio (UNOH)** provided program materials to our automotive students. The automotive program has an articulation agreement with UNOH to allow 2 sections full credit (like a scholarship) worth about \$3,000 of the tuition. Other programs discussed—robotics, diesel, and performance (race cars). Programs range from about 10 months on. The automotive program starts with the diploma program—all hands on and continues up to a Masters in Automotive Engineering. Randy DeBoer from **Universal Technical Institute**—Orlando campus, also spoke to the automotive students. This private school, largest of its type in the US, has a concentrated program of 12 months. UTI has the automotive and diesel programs, also the MMI—Marine and Motorcycle institute for working on all brands of motorcycles and also personal watercraft and boats. UTI also has NASCAR university in North Carolina.
