Increase involvement in your student's school by attending orientation, open house, and the Annual Title I meeting.	Prepare for learning each day by getting an adequate amount of sleep, by having the correct materials for class, by completing homework and projects on time.
Communication - Stay Informed	Effectively communicate by providing timely notifications of activities to parents and students.	If any issues should arise go through the school's discipline office or academic office. Follow up any concerns with the guidance counselor or principal.	Check on my progress using student portal to check grades, credits and other graduation requirements.
Learning Environment	Provide students a supportive, safe and effective learning environment.	Promote learning at home by making sure your student has suitable time and place for homework.	Respect myself, all school staff and others by being courteous, cooperative and positive in my accounts.
