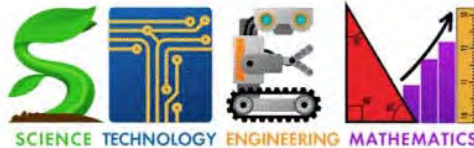

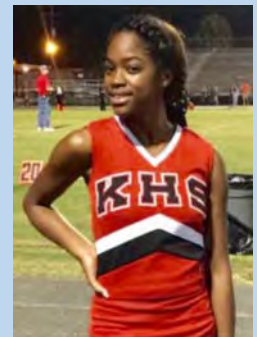

Because of Irma, the College Board will offer a free November SAT registration and a CSS Profile fee waiver. The free November SAT registration and CSS Profile fee waiver are for students who are experiencing hardship and/or displacement due to the hurricane and are in an area designated by FEMA. Please scroll down for the list of FEMA counties.

- Students who are registered for the November SAT should call Customer Service to receive a refund of their registration and late fee. Students can register and contact Customer Service through October 25. To reach Customer Service, please call 866-756-7346.

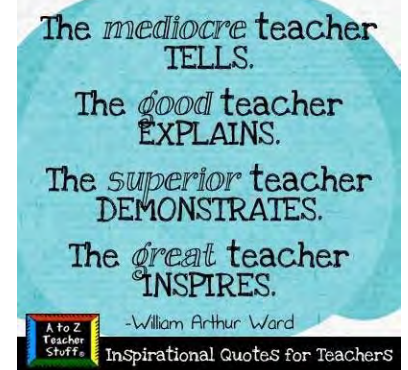
Brandon Alderman, one of the top students at CFAA/KHS continues to be a model

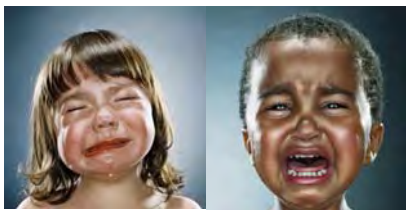
Local CITGO Business supports Kathleen High School
