Graduating High School Senior dependents and Military Spouses of all ranks of active duty, retired or deceased members of any branch of the US Armed Services are encouraged to apply.

Scholarships are merit-based and are evaluated on a combination of academics, essay, volunteerism and leadership. Applications for 2018 must be postmarked by **February 15, 2018**. Applications will not be considered if all required elements are not postmarked by that date. You must be a resident of Hillsborough, Manatee, Pasco, Pinellas, or Polk counties. If you are a military spouse, you can re-apply if you have not previously won.

You can apply if you attend a private, public or homeschool. If you receive any type of full scholarship from another funding source, you will no longer be eligible for our scholarship.
